The Masifunde reader series is aimed at Primary School learners, Grade 1 to 7.

About the readers

The Masifunde readers are simple readers. They are available in 6 different levels that increase in difficulty.

- Level 0 is simple vocabulary in short sentences.
- Levels 1 to 4 contain two questions per page, a vocabulary list, and summative questions.
- Level 5 contains longer passages of text with an increased level of grammar.

Within each level the books also increase in difficulty. For example, in Level 0, the first book (MRL001) is the easiest book in the level, whereas the fifth book (MRL005) is the most difficult book in the level.

The Fundaville reader series is aimed at High School learners, Grade 8 to 12.

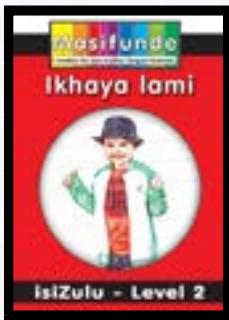
This reader will teach you basic phrases that you can use when going to the shops. You will be able to happily push your trolley around the shops and refer to the basic items in isiZulu.

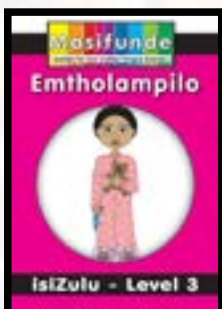


TITLE: Sithanda izithelo nemifino (We love fruit and vegetables)

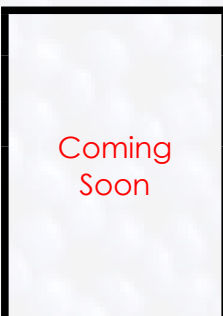

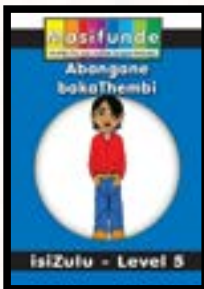


TITLE: **UCaitlin umenyiwe ephathini** (Caitlin goes to a party)
